SUBMISSION DETAILS:

Abstracts should include the title; authors' names; corresponding author's contact information; and, a brief narrative of the objectives, methods, findings and conclusions of the work to be presented OR a full description of the workshop or interactive session concept. Identify whether a paper will be submitted and the nature of the presentation or session proposal (e.g. poster, podium, workshop, interactive panel). Abstract submissions should not exceed one (1) typewritten page and may be in Word or PDF format. Accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings.
